This month, I want to spotlight the 2024-2025 Volunteer Grants which support the work of local community organisations by reducing barriers for volunteers and increasing participation in volunteering. Grants of between \$1,000 and \$5,000 will be available to assist eligible not-for-profit community organisations that rely on volunteers. Grants can be used to purchase communication or insurance items as well as purchase items or services to assist volunteers or volunteer-run activities that support the well-being and development of children (under 18).
